

Directions

Tomperrow is situated on the minor road running from Threemilestone to Hugus.

National Grid Reference 775 443

If coming down the A30, the main spine road into Cornwall, turn off for Truro (A390) at Chiverton Cross roundabout (1st exit) and continue for 2 miles to a roundabout, adjacent to the Park and Ride and turn right (3rd exit) signposted Threemilestone. At the 1st mini roundabout (immediately after the big roundabout) turn left (1st exit) into the village of Threemilestone. When you reach the next mini roundabout, next to Ward Vauxhall garage, turn right (3rd exit) along Hugus Road and proceed over the next roundabout (small painted one outside Spar shop) to the end of Hugus road. At this junction / roundabout turn right and head downhill and you will leave the village and encounter an S bend over the railway bridge, as you drop down into the valley you will see the entrance to the Campsite on the right before you head back uphill.

If travelling down the A39 head for Truro and then follow the signs to Redruth. Immediately after a set of traffic lights on the dual carriageway, with a turning to Richard Lander School, you will find a slip road that says Threemilestone. When you reach a mini roundabout, next to Ward Vauxhall garage, turn left (1st exit) along Hugus Road and proceed over the next roundabout (small painted one outside Spar shop) to the end of Hugus road. At this junction / roundabout turn right and head downhill and you will leave the village and encounter an S bend over the railway bridge, as you drop down into the valley you will see the entrance to the Campsite on the right before you head back uphill.
